On December 19, 2024, Resolution M-4874 was adopted by the Commission changing the Reimbursement Account Use Fees effective January 1, 2025 from 0.7% to 0.68%. Therefore, DOWC is required to file the appropriate change to its **Schedule UF**, *Surcharge To Fund Public Utilities Commission Reimbursement Fee.*

## <u>Response or Protest</u>

Anyone may respond to or protest this advice letter. When submitting a response or protest, please include the utility name and advice letter number in the subject line. A response supports the filing and may contain information that proves useful to the Commission in evaluating the advice letter. A protest objects to the advice letter in whole or in part and must set forth the specific grounds on which it is based. These grounds are:

(1) The utility did not properly serve or give notice of the advice letter;

(2) The relief requested in the advice letter would violate statute or Commission order, or is not authorized by statute or Commission order on which the utility relies;

(3) The analysis, calculations, or data in the advice letter contain material error or omissions;

(4) The relief requested in the advice letter is pending before the Commission in a formal proceeding; or

(5) The relief requested in the advice letter requires consideration in a formal hearing, or is otherwise inappropriate for the advice letter process; or

(6) The relief requested in the advice letter is unjust, unreasonable, or discriminatory (provided such a protest may not be made where it would require re-litigating a prior order of the Commission.)

A protest shall provide citations or proofs where available to allow staff to properly consider the protest. A response or protest must be made in writing or by electronic mail and must be received by the Water Division within 20 days of the date this advice letter is filed. The informing document should include an estimate of the date the proposed protest might be voted on. The advice letter process does not provide for any responses, protests or comments, except for the utility's reply, after the 20-day comment period.

<u>**Replies**</u>: The utility shall reply to each protest and may reply to any response. Each reply must be received by the Water Division within 5 business days after the end of the protest period and shall be served on the same day to the person who filed the protest or response. #### SURCHARGE TO FUND PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION <u>REIMBURSEMENT FEE</u>

#### APPLICABILITY

This surcharge applies to all water bills rendered under all tariff rate schedules authorized by the Commission.

#### **TERRITORY**

This schedule is applicable within the entire territory served by the utility.

#### **RATES**

A 0.68% Surcharge shall be added to all customer bills.

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In 1982 the Legislature established a Public Utilities Commission Reimbursement Fee to be paid by all water and sewer system corporations to fund their regulation by the Commission. Public Utilities Code Sections 401-403. The surcharge to defray the cost of that fee is ordered by the Commission under authority granted by (PU) Code Sections 431 and 432.

On December 19, 2024, the Commission adopted Resolution M-4874 which changes Reimbursement Account User Fees, effective January 1, 2025, from the previous 0.70% to 0.68%.
