Advice Letter No. 537

#### TO THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

Del Oro Water Company, Inc. (DOWC) hereby transmits this Advice Letter No. 537 for filing on behalf of all DOWC Districts (DISTRICTS) for General Rate Cases to modify its Annual General Metered Service Rates. Following the catastrophic wildfire in Butte County (The CAMP Fire) in which four DISTRICTS sustained heavy losses, DOWC needs to adjust previously authorized sales forecasts for the affected districts and reallocate its statewide and regional operating expenses for its current count or 6,903 customers, compared to the prior count of 6,458 customers which was done on August 18, 2020 with Resolution W-5229.

The fire area districts lost a total of 2,162 customers. A total of 470 customers have returned for water service. Based on this information, the recovery will continue to be very slow in this area for some time.

DOWC will be filing (20) individual GRC Workbooks. DOWC requests that the Commission Staff review these workbooks so DOWC can modify its Annual General Metered Service Rates to reflect the losses DOWC has incurred and bring its revenue requirement back to a reasonable rate of return on its assets.

First, DOWC submitted standard GRC Workbooks which reflect rate increases based on each district's number of customers, water usage, meter sizes, and (3) year historical expense history along with the actual increased costs of purchased water, power, insurance, payroll, and health benefits. Expenses have increased 31.17% over (3) years which is approximately 10.39% per year. DOWC's average asset increase total is \$82,109 or .07% statewide and using the requested 9.33% statewide rate of return (ROR), the total net revenue increase requested is \$7,285 or .06% over the previous GRC in 2020. Percentage rate increases (decreases) for these workbooks vary from 73.27% to (10.07%).

DOWC also submitted rates showing increases based on number of remaining customers (6,903) and the net revenue request which would equal \$154.03 per customer annually or \$12.84 per customer monthly over their current rates. Percentage rate increases (decreases) vary by district from 54.28% to (9.68%) due to the number of customers.

Lastly submitted, GRC Workbooks with ROR adjustments by Regions and Districts, where it is shown the percentage rate increases are from 42.66% to 0.98% with an average statewide percentage rate increase of 22.36%. This approach provides no percentage decreases and minimizes the rate impact for the Camp Fire area. DOWC suggests that staff considers this approach for the GRC.

It should be noted that DOWC has not requested any annual CPI rate increases or balancing account offsets since the August 18, 2020 Resolution W-5229 was approved.



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DOWC has filed a claim with Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) and has engaged in litigation with the Trust. There still has not been a settlement amount discussed or received. Upon receipt of any monies from the PG&E litigation, DOWC will file a Tier 3 Advice Letter proposing an allocation or distribution of such litigation monies.

The CPUC staff will make a thorough investigation of the utility's request. Following the investigation, the CPUC may grant the utility's request in whole or in part, or may deny it. Customers who would like to call the CPUC's attention to any problems concerning their water service, or who would like to provide any other information or comments regarding this requested change should do so by writing to the CPUC.

Customer notices will not be sent until Commission Staff and DOWC agree on the recovery method. At that time customers will be encouraged to contact Del Oro at (530) 717-2500 with any questions regarding this General Rate Case. DOWC will also work with the CPUC staff regarding meetings Statewide for the GRC. In addition, there are two ways to respond to this notice. You may send a protest to the CPUC's Water Division, and if you do, you must send a copy of the protest to DOWC, or you can send a response to the CPUC and mention "DOWC Statewide General Rate Case".

#### **File a PROTEST:**

A protest is a document stating that you object to the utility receiving all or some part of its request. If you wish to file a protest, you must state the facts constituting the grounds for the protest, how the advice letter affects you, and the reasons why you believe the whole advice letter, or part of it, is not justified.

If the protest requests an evidentiary hearing (an evidentiary hearing is a legal proceeding held before an administrative law judge at the Commission to obtain evidence), your protest must state the facts you would present at the evidentiary hearing to support your request for a complete or a partial denial of the advice letter. The filing of a protest does not ensure that an evidentiary hearing will be held. The decision whether or not to hold an evidentiary hearing will be based on the content of the protest.

#### **File a RESPONSE:**

A response is a document that does not object to the request sought in the application, but nevertheless, presents information you believe would be useful to the Commission in acting on the application. Comments should mention that they pertain to the "DOWC Statewide General Rate Case".
