TO THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

Del Oro Water Company, Inc. (DOWC) hereby transmits for filing, Advice Letter No. 492 on behalf of its River Island District, Territory 2 (District), its request to establish a Point of Use Memorandum Account (POUMA) designed to track all costs which are associated with and are incurred while attempting to solve a major water quality issue within the service area using the most economically viable option. That option is believed to be the installation of Point of Use (POU) technology in each residence. The investigative process requires close coordination with our engineers and the State Water Board regarding a Pilot Study and a protocol for installing and monitoring the project. Other associated costs are to be determined.

The POUMA will track all expenses associated with the project for future disposition.

On March 15, 2016 the State Water Board adopted Resolution No. 2016-0015, allowing the use of POU devices in lieu of centralizing treatment. The Resolution also set forth a very specific process for the use of the devices. The entire process is overseen by the State of California, State Water Board Division of Drinking Water.

Prior to recovery, charges made to the POUMA are subject to a reasonableness review in the next General Rate Case or appropriate Advice Letter filing for that District. The recovery of under-collections or refunds of over-collections will be passed on to the ratepayers through volumetric surcharges or surcredits, respectively.

- PURPOSE: The purpose of the POUMA is to recover any and all costs which are incurred
 due to DOWC's efforts to solve water quality issues within River Island District,
 Territory 2 including, but not limited to, applicable engineering, legal and other costs associated with
 pilot testing, installation protocols and other related matters which may require a substantial outlay of
 funds.
- 2. ACCOUNTING PROCEDURE: DOWC may maintain a POUMA for its expenses and other recovery/reimbursement in connection with unanticipated costs as described above. These expenses must be additional or incremental to those allowed in DOWC's last general rate case proceeding. DOWC shall make entries to this account at the end of each month as follows:
 - a. A credit or debit entry equal to the amounts recorded in DOWC's legal, engineering and General Expense Accounts for the District's costs to implement the Point of Use Study and subsequent installations.
 - A debit or credit entry to transfer all or a portion of the balance in the POUMA for rate recovery as may be approved by the CPUC.
- 3. EFFECTIVE DATE: DOWC Requests the effective date be March 1, 2017.
- DISPOSITION: Disposition of amounts recorded in the POUMA account will be determined in a regulatory proceeding, as authorized by the Commission.
