BOIL WATER NOTICE

Boil Your Water Before Drinking or Food Preparation to Avoid Illness

Due to the main line repair and system shut down, which occurred on April 2, 2024, the State Water Resources Control Board, Division of Drinking Water, the Tuolumne County Health Department, and the Del Oro Water – Strawberry District are advising residents of Strawberry, CA to only use boiled tap water or bottled water for drinking and cooking purposes as a safety precaution to avoid stomach or intestinal illness. The affected area includes in case of **full shut-off**: Blackbird Lane, Grosbeak Lane, Kell Lane, Meadow Dr, Pine Avenue, Quail Drive, River Drive, Robin Lane, Stan Court, Tanager, Whipoorwill Drive, Wild Oats Drive, Winter Way, Wren Lane, 31880 - 31920 State Hwy 108, 28010 - 28675 Strawberry Drive and 28129 - 31817 Old Strawberry Road. The affected area includes in case of **partial shut-off**: 28481 and 28487 River Drive. Please see website for more details.

We will inform you when tests show that water is safe to drink, and you no longer need to boil your water. We anticipate resolving the problem by Tuesday April 9, 2024.

Do not drink the water without boiling it first

- Boil all water for one (1) minute (rolling boil).
- Let water cool before drinking.
- Use boiled or bottled water for drinking, brushing teeth, and food preparation until further notice.
- Boiling water kills bacteria and other organisms in the water.

If you are unable to boil your water:

Household unscented liquid bleach

- For clear water, use 8 drops (1/8 tsp.) of bleach for 1 gallon of water. For cloudy water, filter through a clean cloth and use 16 drops (1/4 tsp.) of bleach for 1 gallon of water.
- Mix well. Allow to stand for 30 minutes before using.
- Water may taste or smell like chlorine. This means disinfection has occurred.

Water disinfection tablets

- Please follow the manufacturer's instructions.
