

UNSAFE WATER ALERT

Del Oro Water, River Island Territory 1

DO NOT DRINK YOUR WATER
Failure to follow this advisory could result in illness.

This notice only applies to customers in the upper zone of Montgomery Ranch: all of Coyote Dr., Thomas Dr., Talboy Dr., Roberts Dr., Wrangler Dr., Winchester Dr., Cattle Dr., and the southern section of Goat Ranch Rd. located between Wardlaw Dr. and Coyote Dr. in River Island Territory #1. This does not apply to any other customers in River Island Territory #1 or Territory #2.

Due to excessive water demand, the system was not able to fill the tank serving the above area, and some homes lost water pressure. As a precaution, water should not be consumed or used for cooking until sampling can be completed.

DO NOT USE THE TAP WATER FOR DRINKING AND COOKING UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE.

What should I do?

- **DO NOT DRINK YOUR TAP WATER---USE ONLY BOTTLED WATER.** Bottled water should be used for all drinking (including baby formula and juice), brushing teeth, washing hands, bathing, washing dishes, making ice and food preparation **until further notice**.
- **DO NOT TRY AND TREAT THE WATER YOURSELF.** Boiling, freezing, filtering, adding chlorine or other disinfectants, or letting water stand will not make the water safe.
